

# Speaker Boehner Legacy: Discretionary Budget

## On Pace for \$2.2 Trillion in Cuts

**\$294 Billion in actual cuts so far**

- ✓ The January 2011 baseline reflected the Democrat level of spending we inherited from them.
- ✓ Data below covers CBO's Baseline changes since January 2011 through its estimates in its August 2015 update.
- ✓ **Relative to that baseline, CBO estimates that over the FY 2011-FY2025 period discretionary spending would be cut \$2.2 trillion.**
